State/Local Laws Relating to School Bus Transportation

- 1. To be eligible to ride a school bus, students must live at least one and one-half (1 ½) miles from the school which they attend unless the situation is deemed hazardous.
- 2. A school bus cannot leave the approved route to pick up a student who lives less than .3 mile from the main route without approval first.
- 3. School bus stops must be at least two-tenths mile apart unless deemed hazardous by the director of transportation. Please notify transportation immediately If you feel your child's bus stop is in a hazardous location.
- 4. Bus drivers are required to drive only on approved routes and to make only
